How to improve the well-being and living conditions of the orphans after their 18s?



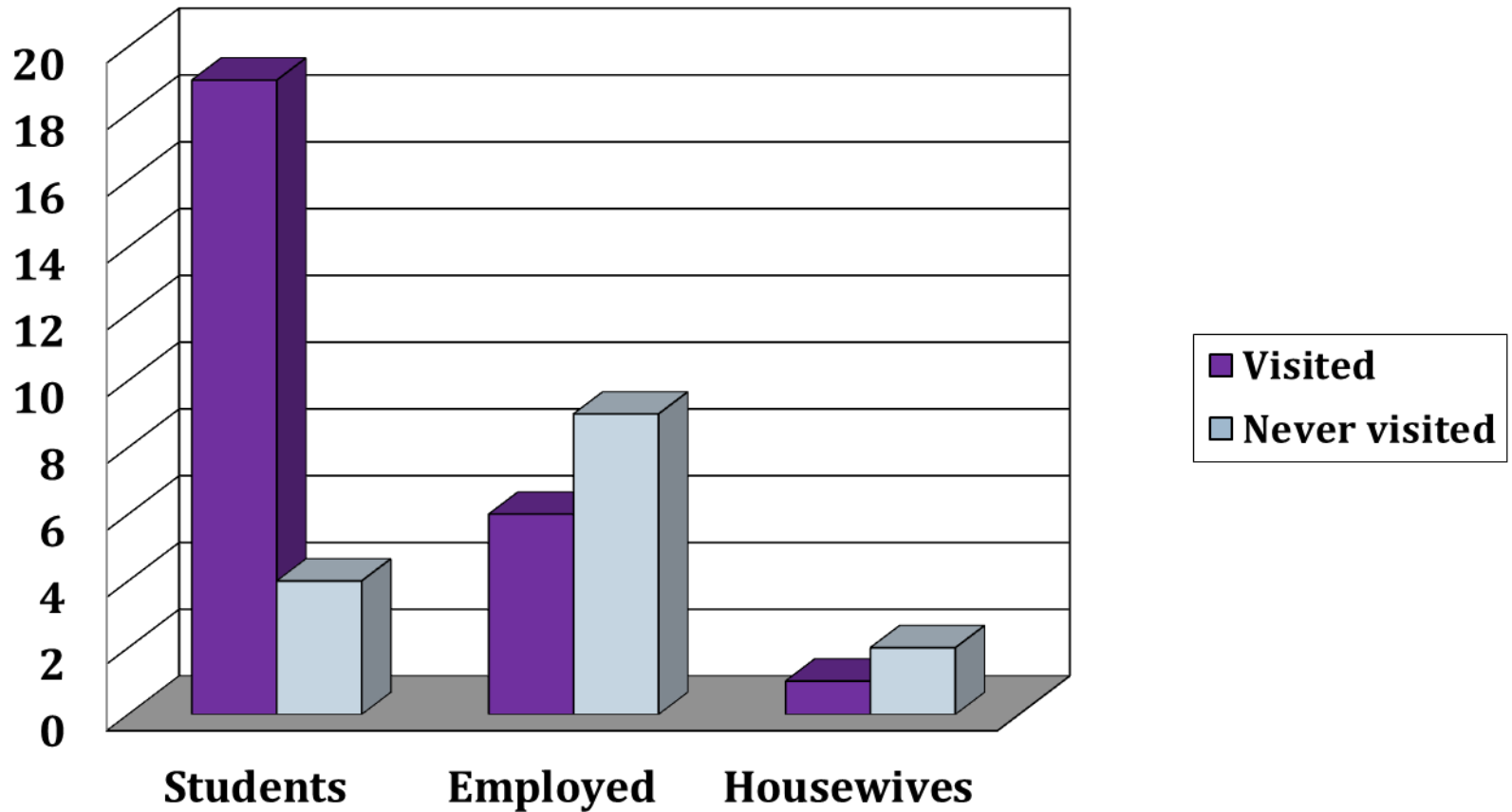

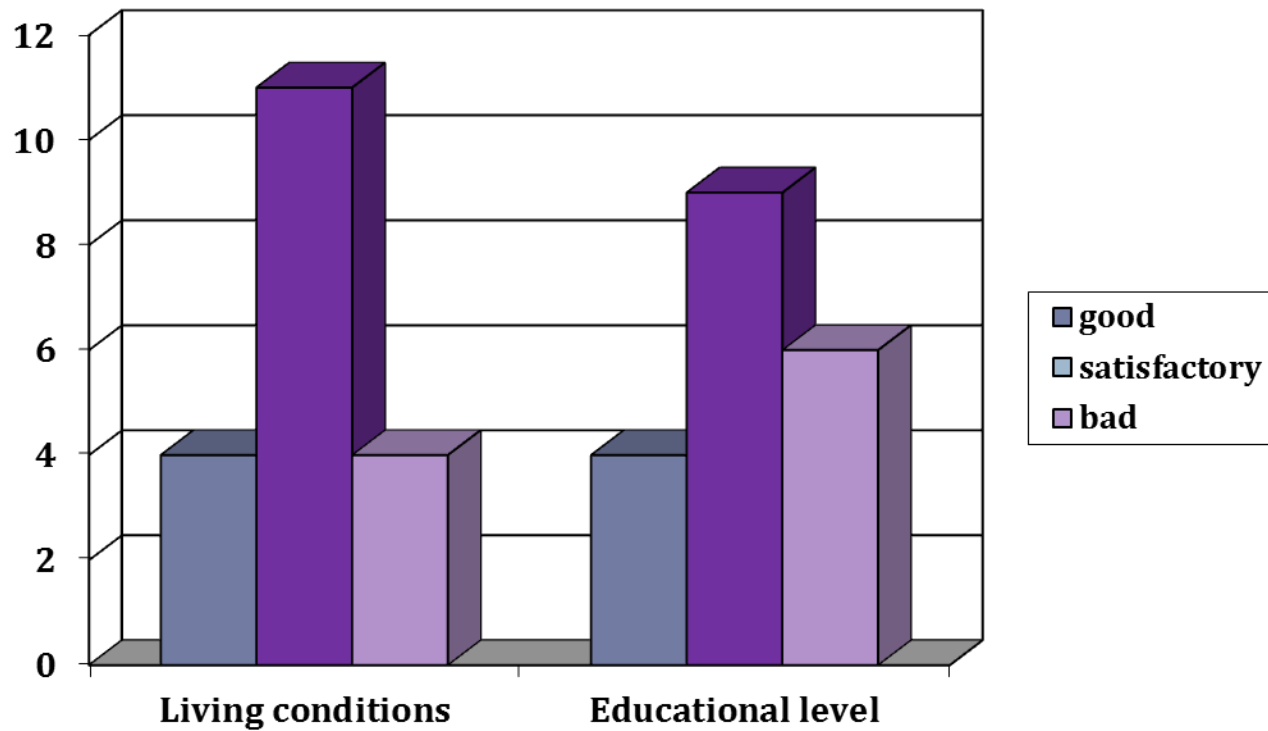

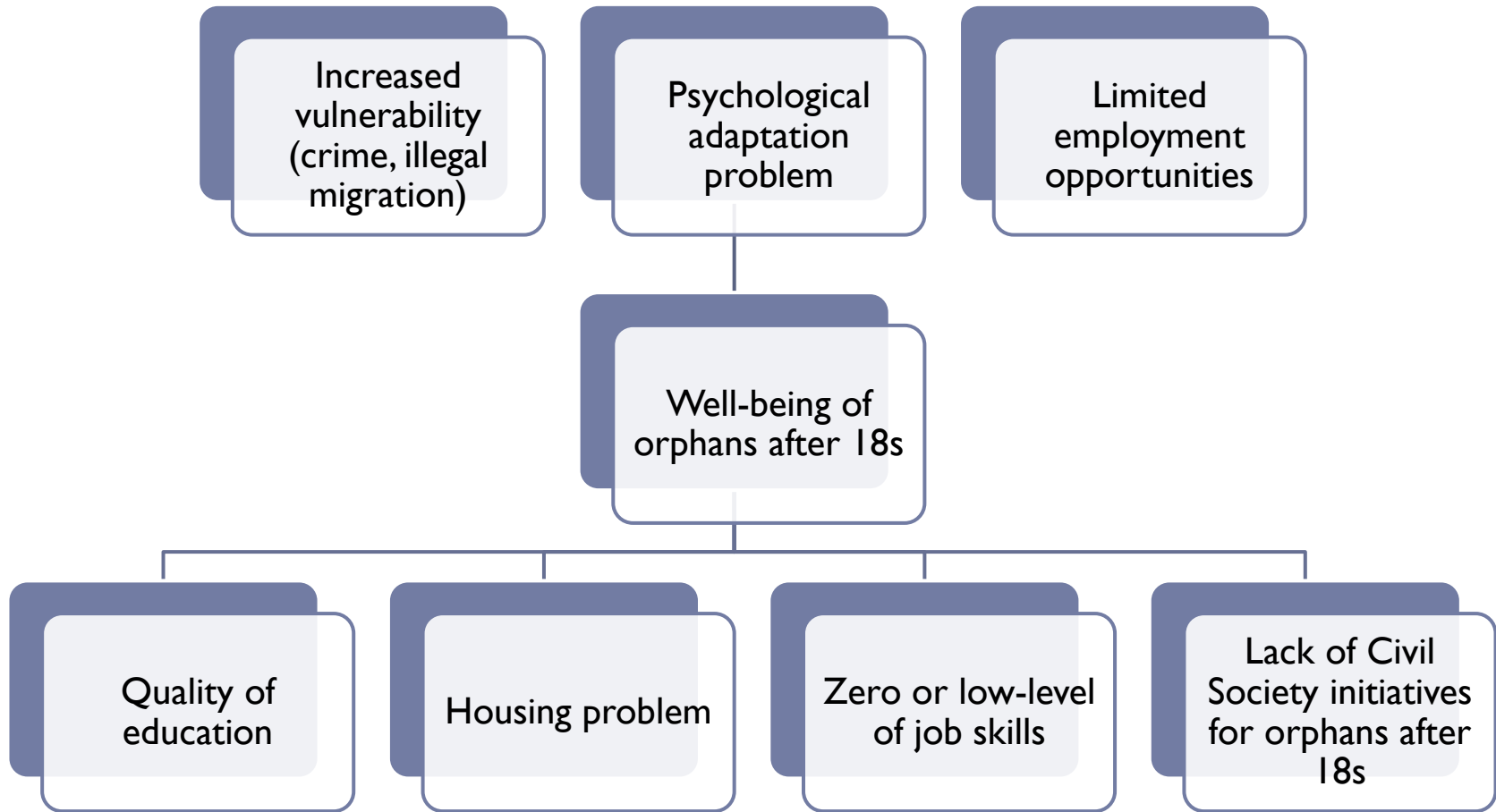


Qualitative research

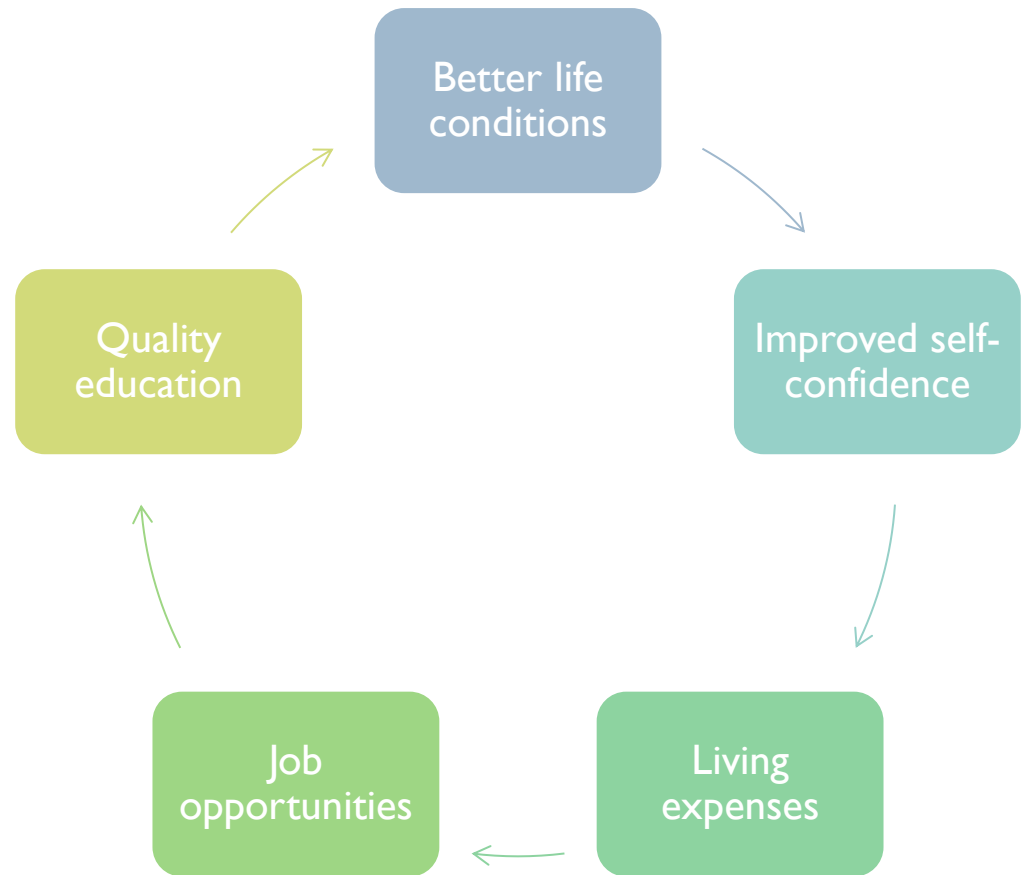
